### PERUSE

1 Corinthians 10:13 (NLT) *The temptations in your life are no different from what others experience. And God is faithful. He will not allow the temptation to be more than you can stand. When you are tempted, he will show you a way out so that you can endure.*

### PONDER

1. What temptation(s) are you struggling with right now?
2. Describe your successes and your failures in dealing with this? Do you see a pattern?
3. What promise is offered because of God's faithfulness to you? How can you use these words to help you in your struggle?

### PERUSE

2 Timothy 2:13 (NLT) *If we are unfaithful, He remains faithful, for He cannot deny who He is.*

### PONDER

1. Recall a time when you pulled away from God. How did you feel without Him? At what point did you decide to return to fellowship with Him?
  
2. What does it mean to you to know that God is faithfully waiting for you because that is His patient, loving nature?
  
3. Describe ways that you spend time with God, reflecting on what moments are most meaningful to you.

Father God, how great you are! There is no denying You are the One True God. Even when I fall away from you, you wait patiently for me to return. Thank you for being faithful to me. Amen.

### PERUSE

Deuteronomy 7:9 (NIV) *Know therefore that the Lord your God is God; he is the faithful God, keeping his covenant of love to a thousand generations of those who love him and keep his commandments.*

### PONDER

1. **Covenant** is defined as: an agreement between God and the ancient Israelites, in which God promised to protect them if they kept His law and were faithful to Him. Jesus' sacrifice established a new covenant for ALL who accept Him as their Savior.

How is your faith impacted knowing that God has made this formal agreement with you and for you?

2. This verse states that this agreement is "his covenant of love to a thousand generations". In what ways are you sharing God's Word with younger generations?
3. What feelings come to you when you learn that God is faithful to YOU?

### PRAY

Dear God, I know that you are my faithful Father. Your Word tells me this and I put my trust in that truth. I am so grateful that I am known and loved by You. In Your Son's Name I pray. Amen.

### PERUSE

Psalm 91:4-6 (NLT) *4a He will cover you with his feathers. He will shelter you with his wings. 4b His faithful promises are your armor and protection. 5 Do not be afraid of the terrors of the night, nor the arrow that flies in the day. 6 Do not dread the disease that stalks in darkness, nor the disaster that strikes at midday.*

### PONDER

1. Describe (or draw!) the imagery you get from verse 4a.
  
2. Where does your armor and protection come from?
  
3. What fear, dread, or disaster do you need to place under God's protection at this time? Relinquish it to his faithful strength right now.

### PRAY

My God, my Father, You are my protector, just as a mother bird shelters her babies from a storm! When I am feeling vulnerable and afraid, help me to feel your faithful presence. Thank you for being my Savior. Amen and Amen.

## DAY FIVE

### PERUSE

Lamentations 3:22-23 (NLT) *22 The faithful love of the Lord never ends! His mercies never cease. 23 Great is his faithfulness; his mercies begin afresh each morning.*

### PONDER

1. How does it make you feel to see that God's faithful love and mercy for you is never ending? (Underline never ending with emphasis)
  
2. **Mercy** can be defined as: withholding the punishment that is deserved. Is there an area of your past that you are holding on to with guilt and shame instead of accepting God's faithful mercy? Reread Lamentations 3:22-23. Let the meaningfulness sink in and allow God's love to clear your slate.
  
3. God does not hold grudges or keep score. Each morning is a brand-new start. In what ways can you demonstrate your gratitude to God for this merciful gift?

### PRAY

Dear God, I love that each day is a fresh start for me in Your Eyes! I want to hold these words of Your faithful love never ending in my heart as a constant reminder of your devotion to me. Thank you for loving me and for accepting my love in return. In Jesus' Name, Amen.
