## **DAY TWO**

#### **PERUSE**

Lamentations 3:22-26 (NLT) 22 The faithful love of the Lord never ends! His mercies never cease. 23 Great is his faithfulness; his mercies begin afresh each morning. 24 I say to myself, "The Lord is my inheritance; therefore, I will hope in him!" 25 The Lord is good to those who depend on him, to those who search for him. 26 So it is good to wait quietly for salvation from the Lord.

#### **PONDER**

- 1. Is there some sin in your life that you think God won't forgive? Take a moment of quiet reflection to embrace the fact that God's steadfast love and mercy are greater than any sin. He promises forgiveness.
- 2. According to the verses above, what does God want from you?
- 3. How would you describe your relationship with God? (Reflect on when you talk to God, circumstances under which you pray, and how often you fellowship with Him)

## **DAY THREE**

#### **PERUSE**

Psalm 23:1-6 (ESV) 1 The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. 2 He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside still waters. 3 He restores my soul. He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. 4 Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me. 5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. 6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

#### **PONDER**

- 1. These verses offer wonderful glimpses into God's nature and desires for you. Underline phrases that are particularly meaningful to you.
- 2. What dark valley are you walking through currently? Close your eyes and allow yourself to feel God's presence—for He is with you, wanting to comfort you.
- 3. Write out the second half of verse 6. How is your faith impacted knowing this is the ultimate promise of God?

#### **PERUSE**
